[Kids Across Cultures](#), a nonprofit focused on providing children with water, education, and healthcare, has invited Sweetwater to explore potential projects in northern Cambodia that address short-term and long-term strategies for improving water security.

The total cost of the 2-week trip in June 2019, including time and materials before and after the visit to research appropriate technology, is \$7,000. Kids Across Cultures has graciously offered to cover travel costs, totaling approximately \$2,400.

SWEETWATER'S MISSION

- Develop prefilters for the ceramic home filters KAC has installed to extend the filter life. Sweetwater is working to construct prefilters from materials that are locally sourced, natural, inexpensive, and recyclable.
- Improve water storage to alleviate water shortage stress during the lengthy dry season.
- Conduct a first-pass natural resource inventory and catchment assessment. Where does the water come from? How is it used? How is water disposed and where does it flow after use? What are local natural resources that can be leaned upon to alleviate water stress?

THE SWEETWATER-KAC PARTNERSHIP

For a new organization like Sweetwater, acquiring solid starter projects can be difficult. Kids Across Cultures has offered to help Sweetwater by inviting us to be a part of a KAC project in Cambodia. This is a great opportunity for Sweetwater to use our skills and giftings to come along side of another organization like KAC to help them reach their goals, as well as be a great blessing to the people in the rural villages around Siem Reap.

Sweetwater aims to encourage in the people of Cambodia the dignity of knowing how to nurture their most necessary physical resource: water.
